





## **Project Goal**

To identify equitable and sustainable strategies to connect local food producers and consumers, expand new and existing markets, and improve community food security.





### **Advisory Board**

Form an advisory board with impacted stakeholders and leaders to help guide the project.

### **Assessment Report**

Conduct assessment by gathering data and engaging stakeholders in asset mapping and visioning activities.


### **Action Plan**

Solicit stakeholder feedback on assessment and identify steps for achieving collective vision, including models and strategies.

# **Community Engagement**

Over two years, we engaged 218 people at 22 focus groups in 8 priority counties.

About 87% of participants said they were likely to collaborate
